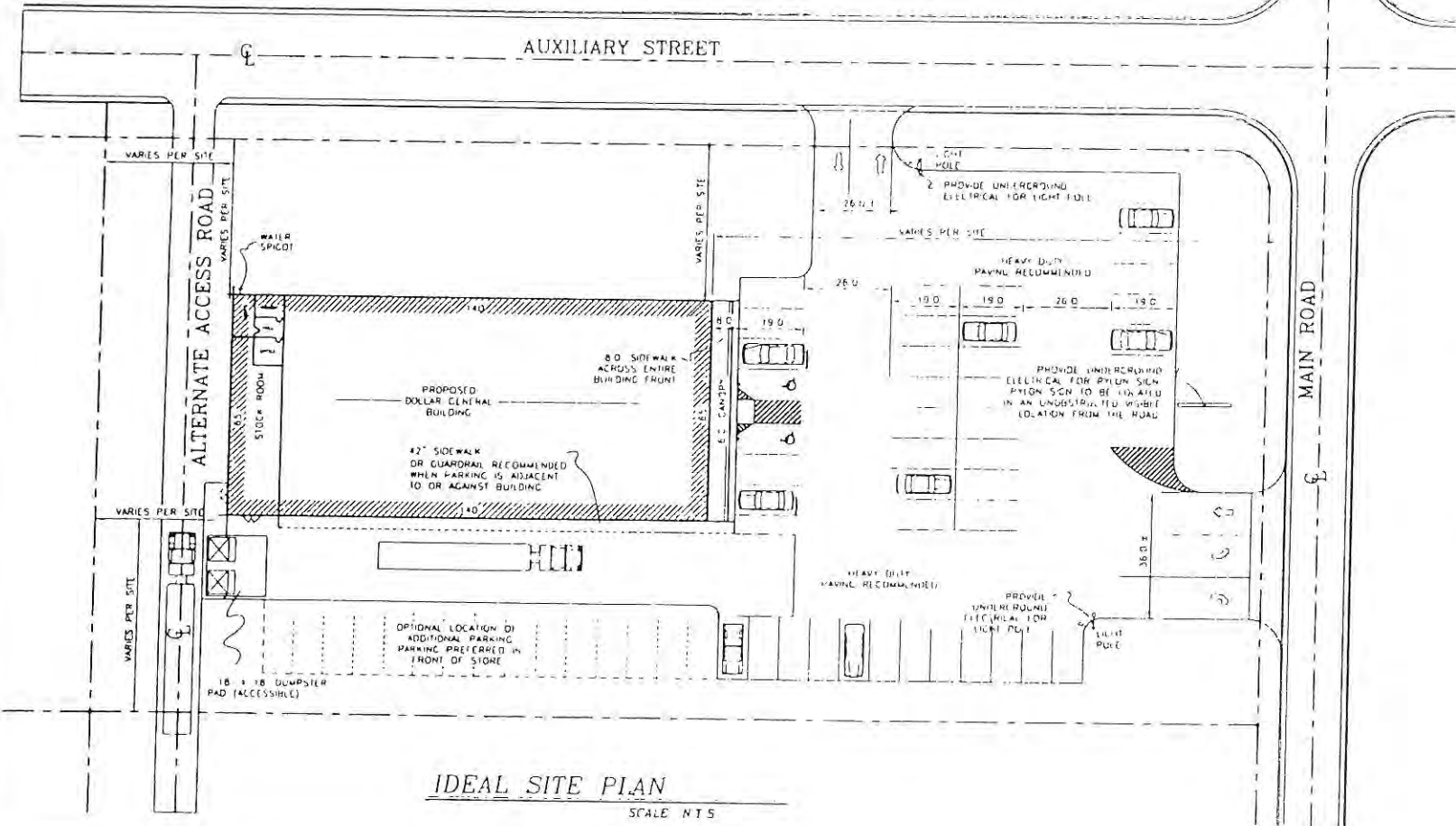
HANDICAP RAMP DETAIL

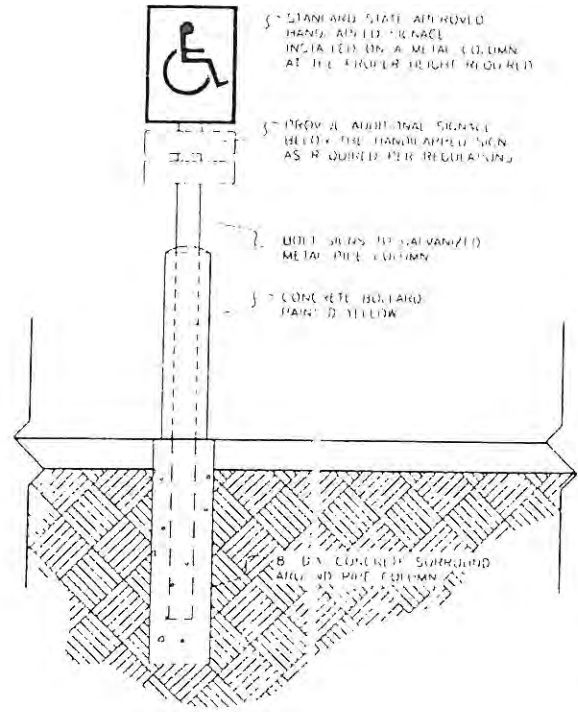
